



# 15 Points of Light Award Harvest District

The 15 Points of Light represent the 3 points of the Scout Oath - Duty to God and Country, Duty to Others, and Duty to Self, as well as the 12 points of the Scout Law. Those eligible for the award are volunteers, with a unit or the Harvest District, who exemplify the principals of the Scout Oath and Law, and who have made significant contributions to Scouting in the past year.

Recipients can be registered Scouters or other adults at the unit level, the district level, or both. Nominations should include detailed descriptions of the person's contributions and achievements related to Scouting. It would also be appropriate, though not necessary, to include a Scouting resume in the application, for registered Scouters.

Scouters, Scouts, or parents of Scouts who have a current association with the Harvest District can make nominations for this award. All nominations are sent to the District Chair who, in conjunction with the District Commissioner and the District Executive, will select award recipients from among those who are nominated. There is no limit of the number of awards that can be presented for this year.

All applications are to be kept confidential to avoid unnecessary disappointment on the part of the nominees.
