

**15 POINTS OF LIGHT AWARD
HARVEST DISTRICT
2009-2010 Year**

To be presented at the District Dinner April 10th, 2010

The 15 Points of Light represent the 3 points of the Scout Oath - Duty to God and Country, Duty to Others, and Duty to Self, as well as the 12 points of the Scout Law. Those eligible for the award are Scouter volunteers with Unit or District positions in the Harvest District who exemplify the principals of the Scout Oath and Law and who have made significant contributions to Scouting in the past year.

Scouters, Scouts, or parents of Scouts who have a current association with the Harvest District can make nominations for this award. All nominations are sent to the District Chair who, in conjunction with the District Commissioner and the District Executive, will select award recipients from among those who are nominated. There is no limit to the number of awards that can be given in any year.

Recipients should be registered Scouters who have made a significant contribution to Scouting in the last year at the Unit level, the District level, or both. Nominations should include detailed descriptions of the Scouter's contributions and achievements related to Scouting. It would also be appropriate, though not necessary, to include a Scouting resume in the application.

All applications are to be kept confidential to avoid unnecessary disappointment on the part of the nominees.

Please submit your recommendation with all pertinent details along with your name and contact information to the District Executive.

All nominations must be in the scout office by NO LATER then the close of business, February 26th 2010.
